Chairman's Review

Interim Report March 31, 2024

The unaudited financials of the Group as at March 31, 2024 were approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting dated April 17, 2024.

The interim results for the period ended March 31, 2024 reflects growth in all key banking parameters. I am pleased to report to Shareholders that Profit After Taxation for the half year ended March 31, 2024 was recorded at G\$2.154B compared to G\$1.524B for the corresponding period of 2023, a growth of 41%. Deposits increased from G\$122.7B to G\$155.9B, an increase of 27%. Loans & Advances moved from G\$60B to G\$78.2B, showing a rise of 30% over the said period last year. These results are an indication of the Group's continued commitment to growth and development. and we will continue to pursue opportunities to further enhance our position

In terms of the global economic outlook, global growth is projected to continue at 3.2% for 2024 and 2025, while Guyana grew by 33.9% in 2023 and is projected to grow by 34.3% in 2024.

Based on the financial performance for the first six months of the year, our Board of Directors has recommended an Interim Dividend of G\$0.60 per share. Last year we paid G\$0.45 per share as interim dividend.

I would like to thank the Shareholders. Clients of the Bank, the Board of Directors, Management and Staff for their support and look forward to their continued support way into the future. Also, I would like to announce the retirement of the bank's CEO. Mr. Prayinchandra Dave effective December 31, 2023 and welcome his successor Mr. Dowlat Parbhu.
